



Notes for Running a Control



End of a section (OUT)

Your control is at the end of a competitive section, riders do not have a fixed arrival time at this control.

- Record the time when the competitor passes the “**END**” of section signs ...see above.
- All competitors are required to STOP at your control for you to record their number.

Your control sheet does not have numbers or times already printed on the sheet, this is because we need to know the order the bikes come through your control as well as the time (in Hours, Minutes and Seconds).

Important points to remember:

- Be organised, have your control set up well before the first rider is due.
- Don't argue with riders make your decision and stick to it, make notes of any issues and report them to ACRM radio operator if you need immediate assistance.
- Make note of any rider who does not stop at control to give number properly as this can entail a penalty.
- If a rider enters or leaves your control in a manner that is dangerous or fills you in note their number and let us know.
- Don't let any vehicles into property unless they are approved (Officials, Medical, Land Owner).
- After the last rider has left on the final lap wait for the sweep riders to go through before leaving.
- Please leave your control area clean and tidy.
- **Please power off your tablet** and return your control sheets, clock, etc. to main control unless we have arranged to pick them up.
- Please take care if lighting campfires, and make sure it is completely out before you leave.

Tablet Operation: *Instructions included with supplied tablet.*

The tablet provided is set to automatically turn off the screen after 10 min of inactivity. To restore the screen, press the top right button on the tablet case.

To **TURN ON** the tablet press and hold the top right button on the tablet case for approx. 3 seconds until the screen boots.

To **TURN OFF** the tablet press and hold the top right button on the tablet case, then select the



[Power off] icon, tapp again to confirm when prompted.
